



When Does a Cut Need Stitches?

Most minor cuts can be handled at home by washing the cut with soap and running water, then using pressure to stop the bleeding. Keep the wound clean for several days, and apply an antibiotic ointment to prevent infection.

A cut should be evaluated by a physician if:

- Firm pressure for 10 minutes does not stop the bleeding.
- Your child has not had a tetanus shot in the past five years.
- √ The cut contains dirt or foreign bodies.
- √ The cut is deep or underlying fat is showing.
- ✓ The cut gapes or has a wide opening.
- √ The cut is 3/4 inch or longer.
- ✓ The cut is on the face (most cuts on the face should be sutured to limit scarring), or overlies a joint or tendon of the foot or hand (seemingly minor cuts may involve serious injury to important underlying structures).






